The HU-1 "BRAVO" detachment aboard the Ticonderoga, assigned as a division of the air department, is responsible for providing rescue/utility services to the ship and accompanying task group. This includes plane guard (angel) duties, as well as mail, cargo, and personnel transfers at sea.

Deployed helo detachments operate in much the same manner as a complete squadron, and therefore are normally self-sufficient in administrative and aircraft maintenance tasks, while the host command provides all the necessary logistic support and facilities.

As the primary shipboard search and rescue unit, HU-1 "angels" have successfully completed 894 rescues since April, 1948, a record of which all personnel in the squadron are justly proud. The "angels" are always prepared to launch, on a moments notice, in the event of any emergency.

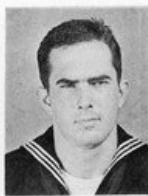

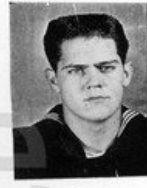

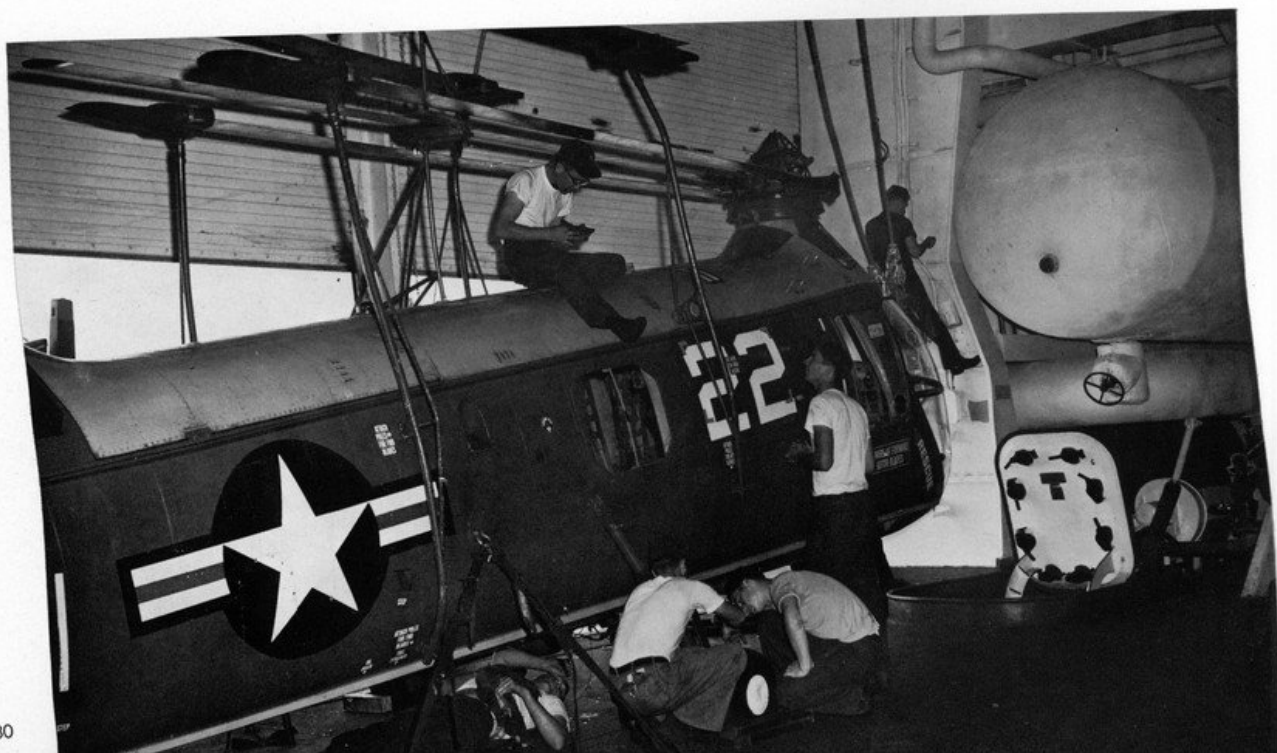
