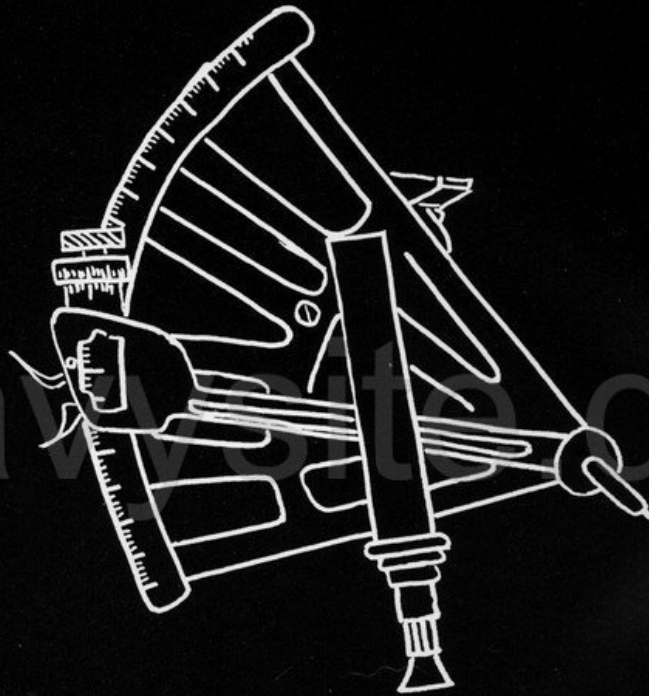


NAVIGATION

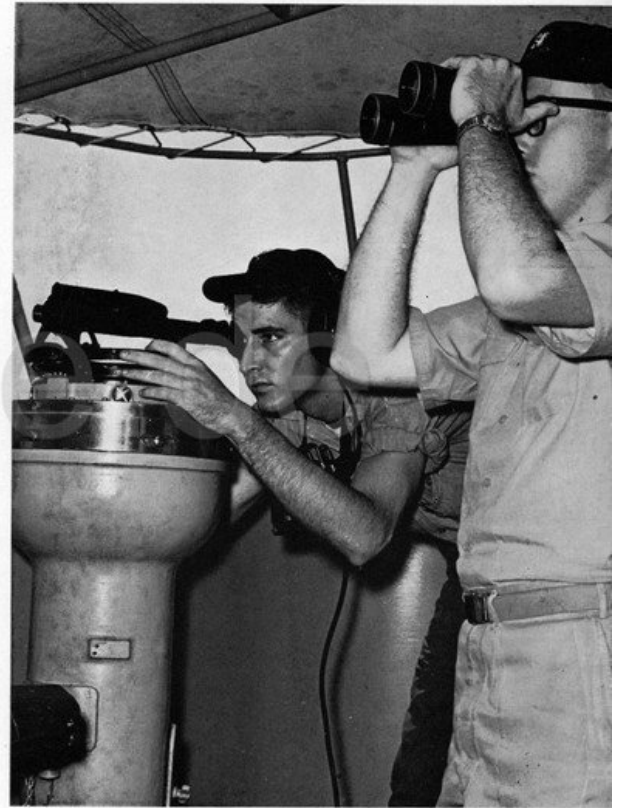
